MESSAGE SERIES: THE LAND PASTOR LEON ENGMAN

"When God's People Inherit"

Joshua 13-17 (13:1-7; 15:63; 17:17-18)

QUESTIONS

- Joshua was at the end of his life's mission, but Israel's work was not done (Joshua 13:1). Why is that an important concept to grasp in the flow of our own life and the church?
- Why does a protected next generation need unfinished work challenges—to take ownership of what is important?
- Why does God give some gifts unequally? Why not all the same?
- What is your spiritual gifting? How is that different than your natural talents?
- What inheritance do we receive equally in the Body of Christ, even though we are all different (Romans 10:9-12)?
- Judah and Joseph receive the biggest, central allotments in Israel as God promised in Genesis 49. What does it mean that, "to whom much is given, much is expected." (Luke 12:48)?
- Why does our constitution reflect biblical thinking when it says that all are created equal? Created means God is responsible, where is the equality, since we are all so different?
