Ten People You Meet in Heaven MOSES

- When did you decide to follow Jesus- how old were you? How old were you when God deeply changed your life? Why doesn't God consider the first 80 years of Moses' life (before the burning bush) a waste?
- Are you completely set on your life's path? Are you open to something new that God has (Ephesians 4:15-16)? Why does walking with God involve being open to growth and newness your whole life, like Moses?
- How personal and intense is your interaction with God (Ephesians 1:17)? Does He know what your attitude is like? Can He withstand your difficult questions (Mark 15:34)?
- Moses had the joy of seeing people taken out of physical slavery. Why is the slavery to sin every bit as miserable and real?
 What part of you has Jesus saved you from?
- If you know someone great in ministry you might be tempted to let them do all the work. Why does that not excuse you from doing all you can (1 Corinthians 12:21-27)?
- In John 6, the people wanted to know if Jesus was claiming to be greater than Moses. What does His answer at John 6:30-35 mean? Does Jesus know Moses (Luke 9:28-36; Hebrews 11:23-29)?
