What Kind of Faith Moves Mountains? Matthew 17:14-21

- What is the contrast between being on the mountain with Jesus, Moses, and Elijah versus the tangled mess in this story?
- What is Jesus saying about the kind of faith his disciples are practicing?
- What are they not practicing- that they only need a mustard seed of?
- Why is standing up straight, ginning up our confidence, and speaking with authority, NOT what God is looking for?
- What does He want?
- How is this desired faith relational? How is it keeping our allegiance (faith as in "keeping faith") and our focus on whatever our King would have?
- How is our faith?
